

# EndNote Importing from EBSCO & CINAHL

## Importing Citations from EBSCO and CINAHL

1. Add the citations to your CINAHL folder by clicking the folder icon.
2. Go to your folder icon in top right and click export.
3. Choose the option to **Direct Export in RIS Format** (e.g. EndNote, ProCite, Reference Manager, Zotero)



4. Click to open the file and then it will show up in your EndNote Library in the Imported Queue.
