

# EndNote Importing Citations from PubMed

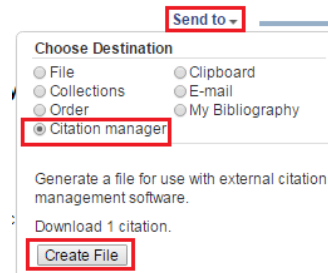


**Objective:** This guide will show you how to import citations from PubMed into your EndNote Library.

## Importing Citations from PubMed

1. Select the citations you want to send.
  - a. **Send to > Citation Manager > Create File**
2. Save the temporary file and then click to open it.
  - a. ( After you open the citation you can delete the file)
3. The imported citation will show up in your EndNote Library in the Imported Queue.

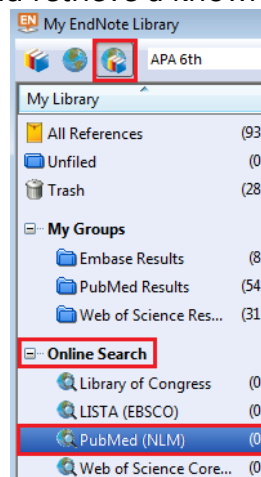


## Importing Citations from PubMed within EndNote

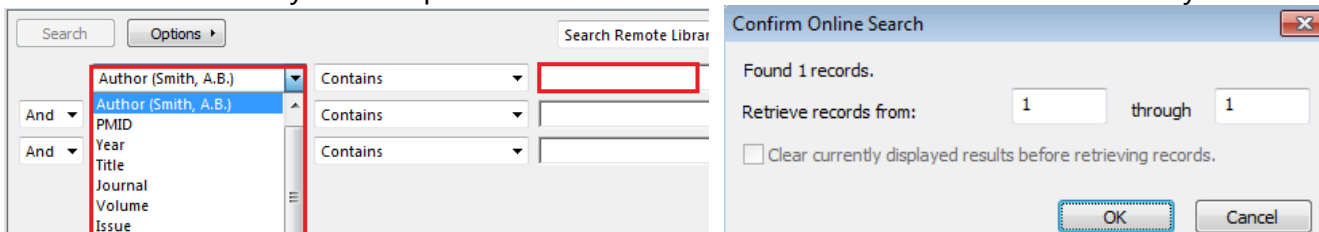
This method will not allow you to view your results before importing the citations into your library. It is recommended that you use this feature to find and retrieve a known citation.

### Directions

1. In EndNote make sure you are on the **book and globe option**.
2. Underneath "**Online Search**" click on PubMed.
  - a. if this is not highlighted blue you will not be able to search.



3. In the search box in the middle of your screen. Enter the citation information. There is a drop down menu that shows you multiple search choices. Hit search then click ok to retrieve your records.
